In 1887, Don **Valentin Bianchi** is born in Italy. In 1910 he leaves his home town of Fasano and moves away from Italy to Argentina, specifically to San Rafael, Mendoza where a promising future awaits him. Passionate and curious, he worked in several sectors while his dream of developing something big grew stronger and stronger.

A General Contractor, pioneer in the wood industry and Councillor of the Honorable City Council of San Rafael, Don Valentin began to devise what would later become his life project: to open a winery and export his wines to Argentina and the whole world.

The dream came true in 1928, with a lot of effort, Bodegas Bianchi came to life. The entrepreneurial spirit and calling of Don Valentin remained throughout his entire life. Devoted to making the best wines, he imported strains and readapted them to the climate and regional soils of San Rafael. Thus, little by little a family winery was born with a name that would become a tradition for excellence in wine.

The legacy continued with Enzo Bianchi, his son, and Valentin "Tincho" Bianchi, his grandson - renowned ecologist that moved forward with the founder's work with just as much dedication until their winery was placed among the most prestigious in the country and around the world.

For 90 years - and 4 generations - the values of a family who has embedded their name in Argentine winemaking have remained intact.

Champagne **Pommery** is one of the 24 Champagne Houses that are part of Club des Grandes Marques Champagne house located in Reims. The house was founded as Pommery & Greno in 1858 by Alexandre Louis Pommery and Narcisse Greno. Under the guidance of Alexandre's widow, Louise Pommery, the firm was dedicated to Champagne production and soon became one of the region's largest Champagne brands. It was she who created Pommery Nature in 1874, the first brut champagne to meet with commercial success,

thereby breaking with the tradition of very sweet wine. A woman in a man's world, she imprinted her personality on her champagnes. The purity and the finesse of Pommery wines perpetuate this legacy.

Pommery is currently owned by the Vranken-Pommery Monopole Group (located in Reims), which also owns Heidsieck & Co Monopole and Vranken, Château la Gorgonne & Domaine Royal de Jarras.

A place already chosen by the Romans to plant their vines, managed for a few centuries by the Archdiocese of Aix-en-Provence, divided into several parcels after the revolution, the area of the **Château Pigoudet** is about the same since the year 1820. To this end, he bought grapes made from premium Loire Valley grape varieties (Chenin, Sauvignon, Pineau d'Aunis, Cabernet Franc...) and then elaborated and blended the grape must in his own cellars. He was recognized as a genuine wine-growing craftsman.

His son Louis, but most especially his grandson, Maurice went on to build Maison Remy Pannier's dynamic and forward-thinking image notably through the development of exports. Thus, for more than 130 years, Maison Remy Pannier has been elaborating and maturing Loire Valley wines with a distinct style, characterized by a quest for fruity aromas and freshness. Bateliers de Loire wines are the craftsmen behind the development of our vineyard; Jardins de Loire wines, the perfect reflection of the art of living in the Loire Valley; Cépages de Loire wines, the expression of our terroir's aromatic freshness.

Remy Pannier, artisan of Loire Valley wines since 1885, pays tribute to the Loire and in this case, signs wines characterizing its style for typical Loire Valley moments.

The **Dufouleur Family** is deep rooted in Nuits Saint Georges in the center of Burgundy's renowned vineyard, since Gilles Dufouleur, born in 1596. They went across the centuries by carrying on Burgundy traditions, secrets of winemaking and by transmitting the taste for elitism.

In 1804, Dufouleur Père & Fils became one of the Imperial court's wine supplier.

The legend also says that the Emperor fell in love with the wife of one of his General (Artillery General Gassensi) who happened to have a house in Nuits-Saint-Georges. When visiting Madame Gassendi, Napoléon was said to be drinking only Dufouleur Père & Fils' Clos Vougeot Grand Cru.

In 1848, Symphorien Dufouleur founded the trading house: Dufouleur Père & Fils. He transmitted his heritage to Alexis Dufouleur, his eldest son, inheriting a full success in a time where nothing was easy: the reputation of Dufouleur wines is already recognized worldwide.

Whites

The fruit is gently pressed using a pneumatic membrane press. Once the sedimentation of the must is complete, only the finest lees are retained. The alcoholic and malolactic fermentation takes place either in thermo-regulated, stainless steel holding tanks (favoring the fruit)

or in oak barrels for the better AOC wines (for aromatic complexity).

The maturation for whites in our cellar last from 6 to 11 months either in oak barrels or enamel tanks.

Reds

The grapes are totally or partially de-stemmed before undergoing pre-fermentary cold maceration to extract color (to obtain a beautiful robe), tannins and aromas. The alcoholic fermentation lasts 10 – 15 days in an open tank with daily pigeage. The skins are gently pressed using a pneumatic membrane press and then the malolactic fermentation takes place in oak barrels.

The wine is then sent for maturation in oak barrels in our cellar between 10 to 16 months.

Dufouleur Père & Fils is proud to represent all the regions of Burgundy.

From the Chablisien region to the Beaujolais Crus, the expression of the terroirs are highlighted in order to sublimate the four main grape varieties: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Aligoté, Gamay.

To reinforce this idea, the Domaine and the winegrowers with whom we work are committed to a policy of careful and "reasonable" treatments, as well as to the use of natural products in preference to chemical products, in order to better protect our environment and to preserve the characteristics of the soil and subsoil which are so unique in Burgundy and thus safeguard the specificity of our wines.

Libre y Salvaje wines - the winery is in the historic town of Almonacid de la Sierra, (in the mountain range Algairén) in the D.O.P.Cariñena region. Recovery is the essence of Libre y Salvaje (Free & Wild). Creating town, landscape and single plot wines which speak of our unique land is our passion. Freestyle, wild vines. Just one rule: follow the rules of nature. Minimal intervention to achieve maximum expression.

An old winery, with an ancient cave for ageing and storage in an optimal natural environment. Wine is handcrafted by gravity with ageing in wooden foudre, stainless steel, concrete, big clay and glass jars. Rescued great abandoned vineyards of native varieties, recovered a cellar with centuries old cave and back to the past to look ahead.

Several years searching & rescuing high abandoned vines in plots along the Algairén mountain range. Organic farming

and autochthonous varieties of old dry vineyards, 35 to over 80 years old, where grapes are firstly chosen in a careful manual selection. We want only the best grapes able to show the terroir and speak of our land, since the goal later in the winery is the minimum intervention to achieve the maximum expression.

Libre y Salvaje wines are handcrafted by gravity, where our intake of grapes is at the top of the hill in which the winery dated back to 1865 was established by the initial owners.

Once the wine is made it is lowered by gravity to our oak barrels and amphoras where we use the cave for all the ageing and storage of our wines before and after bottling them. The depth from the grape intake to the cave is 25 meters.

Since the 1980s, Yuntero has expanded internationally, reaching markets across Europe and the United States while embracing innovation, including early leadership in organic wines. Ongoing investment in advanced facilities and certifications such as ISO, BRC, and SWfCP has strengthened its ability to deliver consistent quality at scale. Bodega la Cepa de Pelayo is an initiative of the third generation of winegrowers of the Pelayo family, with the aim of recovering the family vineyards of old vines and making quality wine using the ancestral techniques of the region of La Manchuela. The grapes we work are Bobal (that is one of the varieties with the highest resveratrol content, a heart-healthy and anti-cancer substance attributed to wine), Macabeo (which is quite resistant to oxidation, largely due to its high levels of antioxidants) and also Tempranillo. We are in Alcalá del Júcar, in the province of Albacete, one of the most charming villages in Spain.

The ages are the following ones:

- For our OLE wines: 50 years
- For our CUPIDO wines: 60 years
- For our LA CEPA DE PELAYO wines: nearly 80 years

The vineyards are cultivated organically, letting nature take its course and respecting the ecosystem, without pesticides or chemical fertilisers that distort the true expression of our land.

The soils that support the vines are calcareous, producing sharp wines, with elegant structure and good fruity acidity in the white and red wines that show great body, quality, very suitable for ageing, aromatic intensity and complexity.

The grapes are harvested by hand, selecting the grapes in the vineyard itself, "bunch by bunch", which are always collected in harvesting boxes of no more than 20 kg

At **Finca Collado** we want to become a reference point for the creation of wines in the Alto Vinalopó area. On the one hand, recovering and empowering native and ancestral varieties, their forms of cultivation and manner of wine making. On the other hand, researching, improving and developing the creation of wines, mixing history with our skills, with the ultimate aim of conveying delight.

In the interior of the province of Alicante, in the heart of the Monastrell production area, Finca Collado combines in its restored winery dating from the 19th century, the traditional and the modern, with the inimitable personality that the winemaker Joan Guia imprints on his wines. In total harmony with the environment, this family winery produces artisanal wines of limited production, seeking the identity of each vineyard of its 26 hectares of old vines of Monastrell, Garnacha, Forcallat, Merseguera, Malvasia, Chardonnay, Moscatel and Bobal in a unique terroir that transmits minerality, complexity and elegance to its wines. Finca Collado is located in a particular geographical unit, an enclosed valley with no access to the sea, at the bottom of which, until 1950, there were ancient salt mines. The Reynolds family has been making quality wines in the Alentejo since 1850 when they arrived to start producing cork.

The Alentejo soon became the home of the Reynolds family in Portugal. Robert, the patriarch, was followed by his oldest son Robert Rafael who fathered, in turn, Carlos. Gloria Reynolds was the oldest daughter of Carlos. To honour his mother and all his Alentejo ancestors, Gloria's son Julian produced a quality wine and named it after his mother - Gloria Reynolds.

Figueira de Cima is an estate of 200 hectares that enjoys the site climate of the Serra de São Mamede. This is a spot of

immense beauty, with fields streaked with intense shades of green, gold and brown. The scenery there is filled with sky and hills whilst the oaks and cork oaks resemble flocks against the horizon. The 40 hectares of vineyard are located at the top of a hill which provides them with good, natural drainage and excellent exposure. The soils are schist-based and the undulating terrain produces an accentuated temperature variation between day and night, which promotes the best ripening conditions for the grapes. The traditional local grape varieties predominate: Trincadeira, Aragonez and Alicante Bouschet. The latter, in fact, was introduced into Portugal by the Reynolds family more than 150 years ago.

It was the mid-Eighties. Silvia Imperato, a former photo journalist, and winemaker Riccardo Cotarella shared a simple and ambitious idea: to make a great wine in southern Italy. The place was already there: a family estate bought by Silvia's grandfather in the Forties, re stored by her mother over the years, the house where summers were spent, year after year, since childhood. The project grew from that place. Around them, a group of friends who shared the same passion and the same vision. In 1991 the first vintage was released, for friends only: fewer than a thousand bottles of a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Aglianico. The wine only reached the market in 1995, with the 1993 vintage. Since then, Montevertrano has

never stopped surprising. Not a replica of Bordeaux, but something more. In 1995 Robert Parker tasted the first vintages and coined the definition that still echoes today: The Sassicaia of the South. Since then, Montevertrano has travelled the world, standing alongside the great wines of Burgundy and Tuscany.

Montevertrano sits in San Cipriano Picentino, within the Parco Regionale dei Monti Picentini, at 100 metres above sea level. A ridge facing south-west, sheltered from behind by the Picentini mountain range, open to the currents that rise from the Tyrrhenian Sea. The climate is Mediterranean but breezy: summers are warm, never scorching, with temperature swings that preserve the grapes' natural acidity and allow for slow, unhurried ripening.

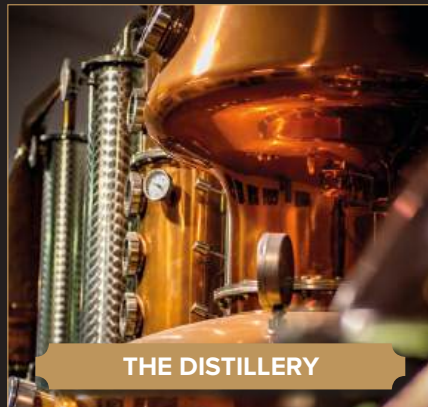

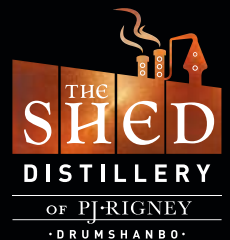
